Fourteen Sansin employees, family members and customers, ages 14+, will participate in this year's competition. The Met Con Blue Adventure Race is not for the weary. Described as “the most inhospitable terrain in the world,” the Met Con Blue Race is a 5 kilometer course featuring 15 ‘hard-core’ obstacles, with 66 percent of those stretches on an uphill grade. The Sansin team is out to conquer this race, including the Sansin High Wall, which is treated with Sansin Enviro Stain.

“The Sansin-treated wall and the swinging tire slide wall obstacles were the most challenging last year,” said Sjoerd Bos, Vice President of Sansin and race participant. “This race really requires a great deal of mental and physical focus, but at the same time, we have great fun and the experience really pulls us together as a team.”
